3-4 pair or underwear

1. Valid Passport (required)
2. Apply for Tourist VISA (required)
Review VISA information on the Tanzanian Consulate website

3. Schedule appointment with a Travel Doctor (required)
Visit CDD website to review required vaccinations
Obtain document showing shots that you have received, keep with your VISA and passport

4. Obtain emergency travel and/or trip cancellation insurance (recommended)
i.e. Global Travel Shield (AMEX Assurance Corp)

Note: Through KIWISA all climbers will get a temporary membership in AMREF (relating to airlift services in the event of an emergency).
5. Register your trip with the U.S. Department of State (recommended)

7. Bring list of Addresses/Contacts listed on page 10 of this Charity Climb kit
8. Bring money for the following:
 - Cash Tips
 - For your climb staff
 - For any drivers

Go to www.kef4kids.com and click the Donate button from Main page

OPTION A: Pay by Credit Card

Complete Donate page (Donor Information Form)

Select Submit button

Select Make a Donation button

- Enter Donation Amount (at top of page)
- Pay with Credit Card (bottom left hand corner)

Complete Credit Card information

Select Review Credit Card Information and Continue

OPTION B – Pay by PayPal

Complete Donate (Donor Information Form)

Select Submit button

Select Make a Donation button (enter Donation amount)

- Pay with PayPal account (bottom right hand corner)

Login into PayPal with your Email and password

Then enter billing information

OPTION C – Pay by Check

Complete Donate (Donor Information Form)

Mail Check to address listed on Donor Information Form; note climber on memo field

Select Submit button (if paying by check – you are done)
